Dear Praying Mother,

We teachers need your regular intercession very much. Your child is your most precious possession, and he or she is entrusted to our care. At our schools we meet many children with just as many different personalities. We see the different skills, experiences and needs. We would like to do justice to all of our students, though this is really difficult, considering the many challenging situations. As a teacher I often have to decide which of the students needs special thoughtfulness and care, often within seconds. Yes, to some of my colleagues and also to myself, this sometimes seems impossible.

I have been allowed to meet lots of co-workers throughout the 38 years of being a teacher. Most of them, and also myself, once chose that beautiful profession because we felt love for young people and had the desire to pass something important on to them. However, during the last years, a lot has been changing in our schools. Many a decision of the school authorities has not proved very wise, and some colleagues have difficulties adjusting to the quickly changing field of work and the new circumstances. Many things need to be done along the way, and because of that, the precious time which should belong to our students gets lost.

Additionally, there are some teachers' personal issues, like bad health, stress in the family, or tensions at the school which hinder the quality of our work. Sometimes we are not successful in leaving these sensitivities behind during our work. We really depend on intercessors, as we realize that we sometimes lack the balance and the ability to keep track of all that seems to be happening at the same time. We need faithful prayer supporters, who, once and again, put us under the Blessing of the Most High and under His Shelter and His Protection against impatience and pride, unkindness and unfairness.

We especially need the prayer for wisdom in choosing the right and really important learning matter and the methods that God may use to lead the kids successfully during the learning process. Besides that, the daily routine at schools also reflects the sad changes in our society. A group of parents demands a great deal from their children and spoils them with all kinds of secular things. Other moms and dads hardly care for their kids and seem "lost" to the world themselves. I feel the silent cry in my heart: They all need Jesus so much!

Please pray in your MIP group for the families, that children as well as parents may meet Jesus personally as their Savior and Redeemer.




Dear MIP Mom, knowing about your prayers for us teachers means so much! You take us before the Throne of God. Through your intercession, your passion and understanding for us grows. Maybe you sometimes feel frustration and lack of understanding or angry and critical concerning the issues with teachers and school policy. But, all these negative feelings will be pushed aside.

How can that happen? If you pray seriously and wholeheartedly, God's Love and His Mercy will break through. While praying continuously for your child's teachers, God will develop your acceptance, thankfulness and appreciation for their work. That way the conflicts that you or your child might have with some teachers can be solved by God's help. God uses your regular intercession to change situations and relationships positively.

During my workday I remember now and then that moms pray for my colleagues and me. That brings me closer to the Lord again. It seems to me as if God's Love can flow more intensely because someone has taken care of the clogged drain. Your prayer, Dear Mom, makes the difference - also at schools. Relying upon God's influence, a lot of good can come about in amazing ways, even if we can't see it in the short term because our God often acts secretly and in His time. Of course, we are full of joy when we are allowed to see the fruit of your prayers. At our school, for example, two believing teachers were employed in the last years! What a great answer to our prayers, and we give God the glory for it. Thank you that you, together with your prayer partners, intercede for teachers and schools without ceasing. Yes, I realize the difference!

Upon doing that, we saw how concretely God's word spoke into the situations at school and in our family. During the time of praise, we marveled at the living word of God and the joy we had meditating on God's majesty and holiness. While silently confessing our sins to God, we took time to realize afresh what a gift God's forgiveness to us is! During the thanksgiving and intercession parts of our prayer time, our perspective changed: we were better able to see how God sees each teacher and pupil individually, how much he loves them, and that there are no hopeless cases in his eyes! He is faithful; he sees into each heart and he has a good plan for each of us.

A teacher also prays in our group with us. Her attitude towards her job, her school and the children has changed for the better and she now has more empathy for each person she is in contact with. The pupils trust her with their problems and secrets..."
